# General Information

This document outlines the financial assistance program offered by Diagnostic Services of Manitoba (DSM) to applicants seeking admission to either Red River College's Medical Laboratory Science Program or Medical Radiological Technology Program.

## Diagnostic Services of Manitoba

### Results That Matter

DSM was created in 2002 as the not-for-profit corporation responsible for all of Manitoba's public sector laboratory services and rural/northern diagnostic imaging services. DSM's vision is to deliver a centrally managed diagnostic system for Manitoba that is sustainable, state-of-the-art, cost-effective and known for its high quality and exceptional customer service.

## The Profession

Medical Laboratory Technologists (MLTs) and Medical Radiological Technologists (MRTs) are essential to the delivery of effective health services throughout the province. In many rural sites, technologists are cross-trained in either imaging or laboratory procedures in order to create a diagnostic team.



## About the ROS Program

### Financial Assistance

Diagnostic Services of Manitoba will pay the costs of tuition and books for the two-year diploma program (an amount of approximately \$8,500.00), provide any additional cross-training that is required and guarantee full-time employment upon completion of the program in exchange for a three-year return of service commitment in a rural or northern facility.

### Return of Service Commitment

The selected candidate will sign a legal contract agreeing to complete any required cross-training and agreeing to provide three years of full-time employment to Diagnostic Services of Manitoba as a Medical Laboratory Technologist or Medical Radiological Technologist upon completion of the education program(s). DSM will determine the rural or northern facility(ies) where the three-year employment obligation will be fulfilled. The provisions of the applicable collective agreement with respect to wages, seniority accrual, vacation entitlement etc. will still apply.



## Eligibility Requirements

All applicants must meet the entrance requirements of their selected programs as detailed by Red River College. Please refer to the Red River College website for more information.

### Selection Criteria

#### Grade Point Average (GPA)

All applicants shall initially be ranked in accordance with their overall Grade Point Average.

#### Interview

Applicants for sponsorship will be interviewed by DSM in April. The applicant will be assessed by a standard set of questions, which will address the following:

- motivation
- self-evaluation
- adaptability
- communication skills
- ability to relate to others
- maturity
- interest/knowledge of rural practice

#### Overall Score

The interview score and the GPA will be weighted equally and combined to yield an Overall Score.
